Reflection on today's Gospel

The miracle Jesus performed with the loaves and fishes convinced the large crowds who were following him that he was the prophet they were seeking. His teaching, healing, and feeding of the multitude made a profound impact on them and revealed his divine presence.

Jesus is present in the everyday encounters of our lives. He is present in those we meet every day; and especially in the poor, the marginalised, and those in need of our help. When we open our hearts and reach out in compassion and love to them, we are also meeting Jesus.

This scene provides a revelation of the sort of person God is! Our resources are never enough, but God has limitless resources, enough for us to do what God wants done.

Jesus reveals the God of abundance, but notice that the focus is on the poor and the needy, not on making rich people richer. Jesus needs our help in caring for those at the bottom of the human pyramid. This is the theme of Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si*.

Point to Ponder

The Church by her nature is missionary. She exists so that every man and woman may encounter Jesus.
