Parish meeting for Helston

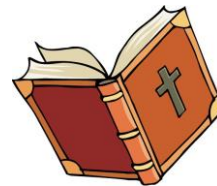
On **Thursday 7th September** at 7 pm in the hall at Helston. Fr Brian would like to see all readers and Eucharistic Ministers from Helston there please.
