### **Reflection on today's Gospel**

If you came today to a startling awareness of the goodness and generosity of God towards the world, how would you share it with others? This was the challenge that Jesus faced from his childhood on, because he had a unique appreciation of what God is like!

Here Jesus uses the simplest of images to help us understand: he talks of bread. In his day, when diets were simple, bread kept people alive; it satisfied their hunger and gave them strength to keep going. Here Jesus is saying that he is 'the bread of life' for them: by accepting his friendship they will be nourished, fed, strengthened, and become more alive.

Jesus is bluntly honest with the people he had fed the previous day. He knows they came looking for him because they had eaten their fill of bread. Why do I look for Jesus? Is it out of love or for what I can get?

The truth can be uncomfortable and make us defensive and even cynical. Or it can make us stop, look, reflect and change. Lord, give me the humility to follow the truth always, because it alone 'will make me free' (John 8:32).
