On behalf of the children in India supported by The Kanji Project Charity, I would like to thank St Mary's Falmouth for the kind donation of £175.

The charity supports a school, children's home, school for children with special needs, and poor villages in the area around Kanji in Tamil Nadu, Southern India.

The money will be used to help the funding for homework tuition clubs and children's parliaments in twenty villages around the Kanji area. The parliaments empower children to speak up and change things in their village, such as better sanitation, mosquito control measures and street lights. Children from different castes are encouraged to intermingle, important in building tolerance and friendship. We would like to expand these opportunities for the village children.
