Bishop Mark has endorsed a study course offered by the School of the Annunciation, delivered online with 6 study days at Buckfast Abbey, which is aimed at parish level for any and all who would like to deepen their understanding of the Faith. Useful for parish evangelisation teams, for parents and for catechists, the course runs for 18 months, and the Bishop will issue diocesan certificates for those who complete it.
