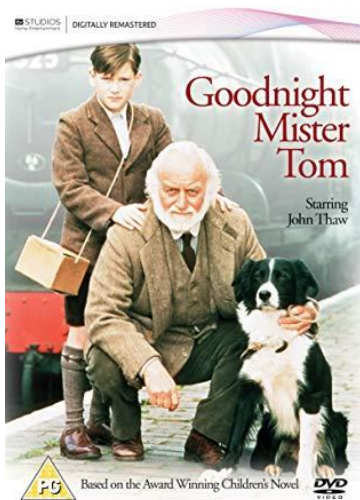
Gentle Keep Fit
