REPLAY:

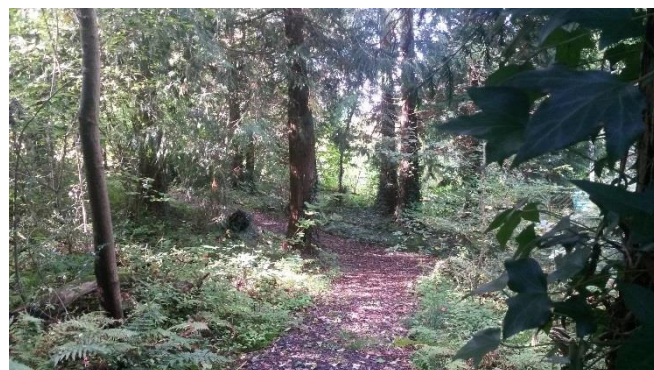

From Father Brian

I would like to take this opportunity to give you an update on the progress of the refurbishment of the hall. The painting of the hall, as far as it can be, has been completed. However, at the end of July an extensive survey of the hall was commissioned, unfortunately the survey uncovered a series of major problems concerning damp in both the floor and the walls. It is a serious problem and needs to be resolved as a matter of urgency, therefore the finance committee have agreed that this essential work must be completed as soon as possible. We are now in the process of obtaining estimates and permission of the diocese to enable the work to be completed. We have to 'bite the bullet' which means the hall will be closed for some time. Unfortunately work completed in the past on the hall was not of the highest standard and this has contributed to the damp. I am sincerely sorry that I have to report this disappointing news and I apologize for any inconvenience caused. This decision has not been taken lightly. Thank you in anticipation for your understanding. Copies of the report are available to read in the office for anyone interested.
