HELSTON NEWS

On Tuesday we begin SEPTEMBER, and so the reminder of the Immaculate Heart, our August Devotion, will disappear from the altar at St Mary's and something to remind us of September's devotion, **The Seven Sorrows of Mary**, will take its place.

September is traditionally dedicated to the Seven Sorrows, and the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows falls on the 15th of this month, the day after the exaltation of the Holy Cross.

The Sorrows are: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the Holy Child at Jerusalem for three days, meeting Jesus on his way to Calvary, standing at the foot of the Cross, Jesus being taken from the Cross, and the burial of Christ.

Season of Creation - Pope Francis **September 1st – October 4th 2020** (Feast of St Francis)

Pope Francis has established Sept 1st as World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation. Encouraging the Catholic Community around the world to pray for our common home.

He calls us all to celebrate this opportune moment to:

- “reaffirm our personal vocation to be stewards of creation
- To thank God for the wonderful handiwork he has entrusted to our care
- To implore His help for the protection of creation
- To seek His pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live”
