### A VERY WARM WELCOME

to all who are worshipping with us today.  
*There is coffee or tea after mass on Sundays  
in the church hall at Helston;*

Fr Paul is going to Buckfast on Monday afternoon and returning from Menevia on Friday, so will not be available during this week.

Please note the extra mass on Saturday morning for the Immaculate Heart of Our Lady.

We are gradually moving back more and more to the ways things were pre-pandemic.

Today we have started using the Catholic Publishing Company's "Jerusalem" mass sheets for Sundays. These are slightly different from the "Emmaus" sheets we used pre-pandemic in that they contain more of the mass, and mass cards are not needed. If there is a feeling that the Emmaus sheets were better for us we can change back at any time, but we need to let CPS know by 10<sup>th</sup> July for the next distribution.

**After 26<sup>th</sup> June THERE WILL BE NO MORE DAILY MASS SHEETS.** As in pre-pandemic, days, the daily antiphons will be provided for congregational use, but if you wish to follow the readings, etc. you will need to bring a daily missal.

**HELP NEEDED:** Fr Paul is in Oberammergau on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> August. Fr David Annear is covering the services, but he has given up driving. He will catch the bus to Helston, but we need someone to drive him to Mullion and bring him back.
