New Teacher Recruitment: Natural Fertility Regulation (NFR) South West - helping build a 'civilisation of love'

We are looking to recruit and train new teachers to become part of a team delivering the Billings Ovulation Method (BOM) in the Plymouth Diocese. Applicants should, preferably, have experience of, or a basic knowledge of NFP, and be willing to learn and use the method themselves. Training will be by 10 monthly correspondence course modules. All learning must be completed within a 2 year time frame. Training is organised by Billings Method England (BME) which is the national accrediting body. Once accredited, you will be expected to attend 2 local diocesan study days per year where we go through charts and revise learning.
