Volunteers needed at St Mary's School

<u>Parish Trip to Mount Edgcumbe House and</u> Country Park

Our parish trip to Mount Edgcumbe is booked for Wednesday 21st September 2022. Pick up at St Mary's Falmouth is at 9am, arriving at Mount Edgcumbe approximately 11.am. Departing Mount Edgecumbe 16.30, arriving in Falmouth approximately 18.30.

Cost per person for the coach is £10. Admission to the Country Park is free. If you wish to visit the house, admission tickets per person: £9, Concessions £7, Children £5. Visits to the house are timed entry: 11.30am -12.30pm, 12.30pm - 1.30pm, 2pm - 3pm, 3pm - 4pm. There is a lift within the house that allows those with walking difficulties to reach the first floor which includes the access to the exhibition rooms.

We have booked a 53 seater coach so places are limited. £10 per person for the coach needs to be paid at the time of booking. You are welcome to leave your car in the car park at Falmouth
