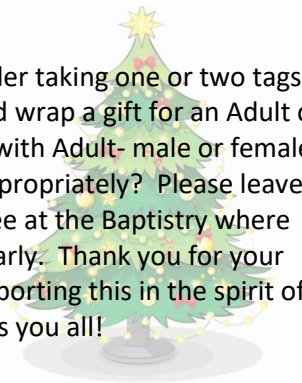
Chocolate for seafarers (Stella Maris)
